

PC RESOLUTION NO. 2022-08
APPROVING A FOUR-YEAR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR
TENTATIVE MAP 2017-03 AT 359 HUDSON STREET

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, the Planning Commission of the City of Healdsburg reviewed the tentative map extension for tentative map number 2017-03 located at 359 Hudson Street that had originally been approved by the Planning Commission in 2017; and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2017 the Planning Commission held a public hearing and approved by Resolution Number 2017-18, a tentative map to subdivide the existing parcel at 359 Hudson Street into two lots that would expire 24 months from it's approval; and

WHEREAS, On September 12, 2019 the Community Development Director approved a 12-month extension of time, extending the map approvals to expire on November 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in response to the Covid-19 pandemic, Assembly Bill 1561 was passed on August 25, 2020 adding additional time extensions for subdivision maps that were set to expire before December 31, 2021, by a period of 18 months extending the approvals to July 17, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2022 the City received a request to extend the map approvals by an additional four years; and

WHEREAS, Healdsburg Municipal Code Section 17.04.130(D) allows the Planning Commission to approve a tentative map extension not to exceed four years; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Healdsburg Planning Commission does hereby approve a four-year tentative map extension of time for the property located at 359 Hudson Street extending the map approvals through July 17, 2026.
